

SETTING SMART GOALS

What is a SMART goal? SMART goals help you to think through and plan what you want to achieve.

Specific

(Think about who is involved in the goal, what, when, why and how you want to achieve it. E.g. I will complete an accounting qualification at ACL Clacton by June 24)

Measurable

(How will you know if you have achieved your goal? E.g. I will of completed the Accounting Diploma L3 and got a Distinction)

Achievable

(Do you have the resources and skills to reach the goal? Think about your answers to the questions on the last page)

Realistic

(Are you able to commit to achieving the goal? Is it realistic within the time and with the resources you have)

Timely

(When will you complete your goal by? Are there certain things you can do by certain dates? E.g. Find out course details, enrol on the course, complete the course etc)
