Information for visitors



IF YOU ARE CONCERNED:

- If you see a learner in distress or a learner tells you something that means they may be at risk always report it
- Never promise confidentiality – tell them you will have to pass it on
- Don't try to resolve concerns, report it to a member of staff who will contact our Safeguarding team, please leave your contact details, so our Safeguarding Officer can get in touch with you if needed

We are committed to safeguarding our learners

We need you to support us by:

- Keeping to the boundaries of the purpose of your visit
- Being mindful of your own behaviours, particularly those that may put you at risk of an allegation being made against you
- Acting promptly if you are concerned about a learner
- Have your visitor ID on show at all times

Some of the types of harm our learners may experience are:

- Sexual abuse
- Physical abuse
- Neglect
- Emotional abuse
- Bullying, harassment or discrimination
- Cyber bullying
- Financial abuse
- Radicalisation
