Business Owner (Hair and Beauty)

A business owner manages and operates their own business, overseeing all aspects from finance and marketing to operations and customer service.

Aromatherapist

An aromatherapist uses essential oils and plant extracts to promote health and wellbeing through therapeutic treatments.

Beauty consultant

A beauty consultant advises clients on beauty products and skincare routines, helping them select items that suit their needs and preferences.

Beauty therapist

A beauty therapist provides a range of beauty treatments, such as facials, waxing, manicures, and massages.

Barber

A barber specializes in cutting and styling men's hair, including beard trimming and shaving. They also offer advice on hair care and styles.

Hairdresser

A hairdresser cuts, colours, and styles clients' hair. They provide a range of hairdressing services to suit preferences and trends.

Hair Stylist

A hair stylist focuses on creating specific hairstyles, often for special occasions or fashion events, using advanced techniques and products.

Massage therapist

A massage therapist uses various massage techniques to relieve stress, reduce pain, and improve clients' overall health and relaxation.





Nail technician

A nail technician provides nail care services, including manicures, pedicures, and nail enhancements like gel or acrylic nails.

Reiki healer

A reiki healer uses the technique of Reiki to channel energy into clients, promoting physical, emotional, and spiritual healing.

Make Up Artist
