## Costs & Funding

This programme has no cost to the apprentice. Employer costs are as follows:

Total non-funded cost: £4000

- **Apprenticeship Levy**

For Employers with Payroll Over £3m: 0.5% of payroll allocated into an apprenticeship account. 100% funding available for eligible apprenticeship training.

- **Non-Levy Paying Employers**

For Employers with Payroll Under £3m: 95% government-funded apprenticeship training. Only a 5% employer contribution required.

- **Levy Transfer Service**

ACL Essex can connect non-levy paying employers with levy-paying businesses willing to transfer unused funds, covering 100% of training costs.



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
